



# Maintenance Worker I

## CITY OF SAN JACINTO

**Salary Depending on Qualifications is \$18.18 to \$20.91 hourly.**

Applications will be accepted until Wednesday, June 27, 2018.

The City of San Jacinto is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Maintenance Worker I to perform entry level duties involved in the construction, maintenance and repair of streets, sidewalks, signs, parks landscape/irrigation, and storm water drainage systems. This is the entry level class in the Maintenance Worker series. Although trucks and other motorized equipment may be operated by a Maintenance Worker I, the equipment is used on a training basis for tasks which are repetitious in nature. Under this training concept, positions assigned to the class of Maintenance Worker II which become vacant may reasonably be filled at the Maintenance Worker I level. General, technical or functional supervision is provided by the Streets Superintendent or Designee. This position may be assigned to any task specified by the Superintendent and the duties will be specified according to assignment.

### **The Ideal Candidate will be:**

- Experienced in construction, maintenance, and repair of streets, and other public works.
- Experienced using light mechanical machines and hand tools.
- Able to understand multiple directions; communicate clearly and concisely; and complete work accurately.
- Committed to working safely and with a high level of respect.
- Dependable, with a strong work ethic.
- Act effectively under stressful or emergency situations.
- Perform heavy manual labor for extended periods of time in all types of weather and have the ability to lift up to 90 pounds.
- Operate a motor vehicle using safe driving principles and practices; and maintain a clean driving record.
- Establish and maintain cooperative working relations with those contacted in the course of work.
- Experienced with computer software to complete daily time records and communication.

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

A typical way of obtaining the required qualifications is to possess the equivalent of:

Experience - One (1) year of experience in performing general construction, concrete replacement, and/or asphalt repair and maintenance work involving the use of hand and power tools is desirable.

Education - High school diploma or equivalent.

Licenses and Certificates – Possession of a valid Class “C” California Driver’s License and a good driving record. A Class “B” Commercial California Drivers’ License is desirable.

Qualified Applicator Certificate for herbicide spraying is desirable and encouraged to obtain within 18 months of employment.

## **Compensation and Benefits:**

The starting salary will be commensurate with the experience, qualifications and skills of the successful candidate and within the range of \$18.18 to \$20.91 hourly.

The City of San Jacinto also offers a competitive benefits package, including California Public Employees Retirement System pension, fully-paid medical, dental, and vision for both the employee and qualified dependents, a generous health reimbursement account, life insurance, disability, AD&D, tuition reimbursement and continuing education.

## **About the City of San Jacinto:**

Founded in 1870, and incorporated on April 9, 1888, San Jacinto is one of the County's oldest communities with roots that stretch back to the earliest days of California. The current population is just under 48,000 in San Jacinto's 26 square miles, with an average population age of 31.6 years old.

San Jacinto is experiencing a revitalization in a variety of development projects, road and drainage improvements, and is growing at its fastest pace in well over 10 years. The community is excited about the new economic development inside the City spurred by the development of the new 480,000 square foot Soboba Casino Resort, new retail establishments (Aldi Grocery, Starbucks Drive Thru, Wienerschnitzel Restaurant and Sonic Drive In, among others to come) and over 200 new homes permitted this calendar year.
